

2 mile high tandem skydive

Imagine standing at the edge of an open doorway in an aircraft flying at 10,000 feet - the noise of the engines and the wind ringing in your ears with only the outline of distant fields below. Now imagine leaning forward out of that doorway and letting go . . . by taking part in The Rowans Hospice Skydive Challenge you will encounter these thrilling experiences:

- **Jump at 10,000ft**
– just like the professionals
- **Freefall 5,000ft**
– falling through the air at 120mph
- **Ride the parachute to the ground**
– steering onto the drop zone

Skydiving from Netheravon Airfield near Salisbury, you will be harnessed to a professional parachute instructor throughout your descent. Training will be completed in one day and your instructor will control your landing. You are welcome to bring along friends and family so they can watch you.

You will receive a certificate to prove that you completed a 2 mile high tandem skydive.

You must be at least 16 years old and must weigh under 16 stone. You will be required to sign a medical form before your jump declaring your fitness to take part.

You will automatically be covered by third party insurance up to £2 million. Should you wish to take out insurance cover for personal injury you should arrange this through your own broker.

We hope that you will take part in this thrilling challenge and raise vital funds for The Rowans Hospice.
