



QCF Level 3 Award in End of Life Care

Course Duration Three days (non-consecutive) 9.30am - 4.30pm

Course Cost £280 per person to include all course materials, refreshments, and a light lunch

Target Audience This course is suitable for anyone wanting to undertake vocational training in End of Life Care, therefore, most suitable for staff working in care homes, domiciliary care agencies and health and social care assistant roles. However, all staff including RN's are able to enrol if interested, especially those new to End of Life Care.

Employers who provide data for the MNDS (Minimum National Data Sets) for Social Care can access Workforce Development Funding to claim back a proportion of the cost of the training and for backfill. More details on this are available from Skills for Care.

Course Aims To learn how to provide support when working in end of life care, and how to support individuals during the last days of life.

 - Understand the impact of the last days of life on the individual and others
 - Know how to support individuals and others during the last days of life
 - Understand the actions to be taken following an individual's death
 - Know how to manage own feelings in relation to an individual's dying or death
