

Wing Walking Fundraising Event

Terms and Conditions

These Terms and Conditions apply to all participants registering for the Rowans Hospice Wing Walking Event ("the Event"). By registering, participants agree to comply with these Terms and Conditions.

1. Event Overview

The Wing Walking Event is a charity fundraising challenge in which participants will undertake a Wing Walking flight experience operated by **Ethel Dares Wing Walking**.

Participation is subject to availability, weather conditions, safety requirements and the policies of the event operator.

2. Registration Fee

- A **non-refundable registration fee of £150** is required at the time of booking to secure a place in the Event.
- The registration fee contributes towards the cost of the Wing Walking experience and event administration.
- The registration fee does **not** count towards the fundraising target.

3. Fundraising Commitment

- All participants agree to raise a **minimum of £1,500** for Rowans Hospice.
- **At least £1,500 must be raised no later than three weeks before the event date.**
- Participants who fail to meet the minimum fundraising requirement by this deadline may lose their place in the event.
- In this situation, the registration fee and sponsorship money will not be refunded.

Participants are encouraged to start fundraising as soon as possible and make use of fundraising tools provided by the organisation.

4. Eligibility Requirements

Participants must meet the safety and eligibility requirements set by the Wing Walking operator, including but not limited to:

- Participants must be **18 years or older**.
- Participants must be in **reasonable general health and physical fitness**.

- Participants must be able to **climb onto the aircraft wing platform with assistance from crew if required.**
- Height must not exceed approximately **188 cm (6 ft 2in).**
- Weight must not exceed **90.7 kg (14st 4lb).**

Participants will be required to complete and sign a **medical declaration and safety waiver** prior to taking part.

5. Medical Conditions

For safety reasons, individuals with certain medical conditions may not be permitted to participate.

Participants must not suffer from conditions including (but not limited to):

- Epilepsy
- Blackouts or fainting
- Severe head injury
- Diseases of the brain or nervous system
- Pregnancy
- Recurrent joint dislocations
- Alcohol or drug dependency

Participants with conditions such as heart disease, high blood pressure, diabetes, or lung disease may be required to seek **medical advice from their GP** prior to participation.

Participants are responsible for ensuring they are medically fit to take part.

6. Safety and Event Operation

- The wing Walking experience will be operated by **Ethel Dares Wing Walking**, a Civil Aviation Authority-approved operator.
- Participants will be **securely harnessed to the aircraft before take-off and remain secured throughout the flight.**
- A **mandatory safety briefing** will be provided before the flight.
- Participants must follow all instructions given by pilots and ground crew.

Failure to comply with safety instructions may result in removal from the event without refund.

7. Weather and Event Changes

Wing Walking is weather dependent. If weather conditions are unsafe:

- Flights may be **delayed or rescheduled** by the operator.
- Participants will be offered an alternative date where possible.

8. Cancellation by Participant

If a participant chooses to withdraw:

- The **£150 registration fee is non-refundable**.
- Any sponsorship already raised should still be donated to Rowans Hospice.

9. Cancellation or Changes by Organisers

Rowans Hospice and Ethel Dares reserves the right to:

- Cancel or postpone the event if necessary due to safety, operational, or unforeseen circumstances.
- Transfer participants to an alternative date if required.

10. Liability

Wing Walking is an adventure activity and involves inherent risks.

Participants acknowledge that:

- They are voluntarily participating in the activity.
- They accept the risks associated with the experience.
- They will sign the operator's **safety acknowledgement and indemnity form** prior to participation.

11. Media and Photography

By participating in the Event, participants agree that photographs or videos taken during the event may be used by Rowans Hospice for promotional and marketing purposes.

Participants who do not wish to be photographed should notify the organisers in advance.

12. Data Protection

Personal information provided during registration will be used solely for the purposes of event administration, communication and fundraising support in accordance with applicable data protection laws.

13. Acceptance of Terms

By registering for the Event, participants confirm that they:

- Have read and understood these Terms and Conditions
- Agree to meet the fundraising requirement
- Confirm they meet the eligibility and health requirements
- Agree to follow all safety procedures set by the operator.
